Dear reader,

This issue of *Papeles de Masoneria* is dedicated to the reappearance of our Order in eastern and southern European countries. It is the first task carried out by the team of the *Pan-European Centre of Masonic Studies and Research*, the recently inaugurated central European subsidiary of the *CIEM*.

Our aim has been to offer an unpublished version of the historic development of Freemasonry in an area relatively little known or understood by western research centres. The members of the in embryo group of study of the *Pan-European Centre* are persuaded that the presence of masonic lodges in Russia and the countries in the Carpathian Balkan region goes back to the first half of the 18th century. This is confirmed by the documents found in the national archives of these countries.

Adrián Mac Liman, president of the *CIEM* and founding member of the *Pan-European Centre of Masonic Studies and Research* endeavours to offer a detailed view of the evolution of our august Order in countries of the old *socialist camp* or, as in the case of Serbia, submitted to authoritarian government systems. The work closes referring to the changes that took place in Eastern Europe after the fall of the Berlin Wall.

Iordanis-Poukouras, from the Grand Lodge of the Scottish Rite in Greece, writes about Masonry's first steps in the Hellenic country, recalling, also, the repercussions of the propagation of masonic ideology in some princedoms of the region: Bulgaria, Rumania, Moldova, etc.

Vojislav Jovanovic, Dragan Mitrovic and Radoslav Petrovic from the Grand Regular Lodge of Serbia go over the troubled history of Freemasonry in their country just before the Second World War and during the German occupation of the then Serbian realm.

Marco Novarino, director of the Centre of Historic Studies on Masonry and member of the Grand Orient of Italy, tackles the subject of the relations between Italian Masonry and the incipient initiatic movement in Albania. His paper has drawn our attention due to its undeniable historic rigour.


